

SO WEIRD IT'S COOL AT CRIS WORLEY FINE ARTS

DALLAS - The work of Patrick Turk is difficult to explain. Perhaps he himself might also be hard to explain. Cris Worley Fine Arts, which opens a solo exhibition of Turk's work, describes him as "eccentric," listing his credentials as a "quasi-scientist and self-taught artist." Regardless, his work is wicked cool and kinda weird. He uses images borrowed from science-fiction novels, encyclopedias, history, and scientific diagrams assembled into highly detailed creations. The exhibition, *Patrick Turk: All of This From Nothing*, opens Sept. 10 and runs through Oct. 8t. crisworley.com
